We live in an extraordinary community. I am very proud of our neighborhood. To the volunteers who help make our events successful, the Block Captains who keep communications current among neighbors, and the advertisers who support our newsletter—thank you!

Some free Leaf and Brush Pick-up dates remain. For those of us situated south of 63rd Street, with Thursday as the regular trash

day, mark Nov. 12th and Dec. 16th on your calendars. If Friday is your regular trash day and you live north of 63rd, Dec. 10th is your opportunity for the free leaf pick-up. For each pick-up date, the city will collect up to 20 bags of leaf and brush per household. Use paper bags, and the bags must be out by 7 a.m. the day of pick-up. For more info, visit www.kcmo.org. As a reminder, please do not place leaves and brush on the street. It clogs our sewers and it is a City Ordinance Violation to do so. Be a good neighbor—sweep up in front of your house and try to keep street gutters and storm drains free of debris.

If you would like to be more involved with your neighborhood association, you may want to become a Board Member. Please call me to learn more about the commitment and/or to have your name added to the ballot. Elections are held at the Annual Meeting. For 2011, the Board has changed the meeting from early January to late February in an attempt to avoid the discouraging weather we've experienced in recent years.

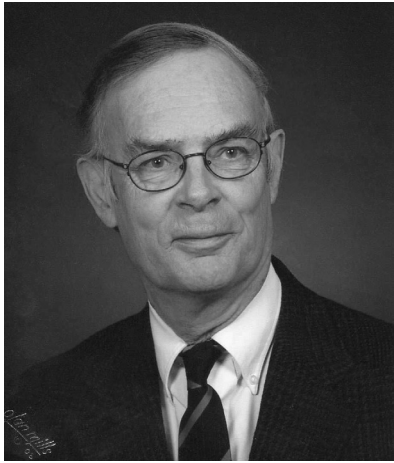

**In Memory of
Neil Bull**

The residents of Greenway Fields, and particularly those on the 400 block of Greenway Terrace, are mourning the loss of their neighbor, C. Neil Bull, who passed away on September 26, 2010. Neil had lived at 438 Greenway Terrace since the early 1970s, raising his two daughters there and turning his yard into a lovely garden. Neil was a neighbor who was genuinely interested in those around him. He was generous with his time, his wit and wisdom, and his produce. He loved his neighborhood and lived by the “shop local” ethos long before it was trendy. His wife, Catherine Anderson, notes that they generally did all of their shopping within a two-mile radius of their house and made a point of doing all of their Christmas shopping within Brookside.

Neil was born in Cleveleys, England on August 21, 1940. Neil and his two brothers were raised by their mother after their father was killed when the ship on which he served in the Royal Navy was sunk by a German U-Boat during World War II. Neil was an avid rugby player in his youth, until a serious injury kept him from playing, and he turned to more scholarly pursuits. His studies took him to Vancouver, British Columbia and then to the University of Oregon, where he received his Ph.D. in Sociology. He came to Kansas City to teach sociology at UMKC, eventually serving as the chair of the Department of Sociology and as the Associate Dean of the College of Arts and Sciences. Neil is survived by his wife, Catherine Anderson, his two daughters, Hillary Bull Urich of Shawnee and Catriona Bull Briger of Philadelphia, his granddaughters Maya and Ally Urich of Shawnee, his grandson Oliver Briger and granddaughter Hazel Briger of Philadelphia, and two brothers.

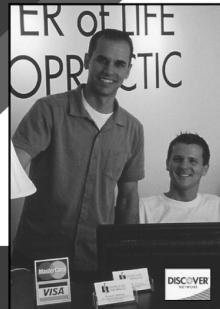

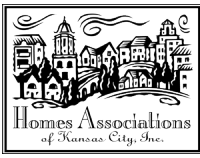
