I. Agenda

II. Old Business

A. Minutes from November 23, 2015 - Reviewed and unanimously approved. There was not a meeting in December, therefore, no December 2015 Minutes.

III. New Business

- A. President's Update David
 - 1. Security: Highwood's (Plaza) Security firm "Chelsea Brown" was not interested in temporary security to augment current arrangement and wanted longer commitment. Another company, "Heartland Risk Management", would be able to do education in-services and risk training for residents, but no patrolling. They said crime historically increases November and December in most areas of the metro. "Securitas" never replied.
 - 2. Snow Removal: There has been two episodes of snow requiring snow removal thus far. David has requested they call him <u>before</u> each time for approval.
 - 3. February all community "Annual Meeting": Charlie Hooper's has been reserved for February 6th meeting and proposed agenda reviewed. Sarah will have a check prepared. Bob Jump will bring microphone and amplifier. Cady will do a Mail Chimp message about Annual Meeting, and recruitment for abandoning roles (interests in tech, landscaping, etc). She will also remind residents to shovel sidewalks and move cars for snow removal.
 - 4. Attendance Policy: Board to discuss proposing an attendance policy at a later date.
 - 5. Brookside Business Association: David has reached out to BBA for sharing &/or participating in GFHA Centennial Celebration.
- B. <u>Treasurer's Update</u> deferred until Sarah present.
- C. Meyer Column Restoration Nola
 - 1. Restoration work completed and reimbursement is pending. Nola will follow-up with State Farm Insurance and Sarah.
- D. <u>Strawn Park Drainage Issue / Repair All</u>
 - 1. Atlantis Drainage Solutions bid to re-grade and re-seed was \$2,350. Van Liew's was contacted regarding moving concrete bench (5 pieces) and two statues, then re-setting after grading completed. Charlie Brown from Stone Bridge Outdoor gave a bid of \$15,000 to move, store, grade, re-set. They offer no guarantees for damage to statuary. Nola proposes getting a cohesive plan for the five green spaces in GFHA from our Soil Service contact. A vote was taken to allow up to \$700 for a plan from Soil Service to include discussion of moving statues &/or benches. Board voted unanimously to approve. In
